- Ensure full functionality of ZOOM by downloading and installing **ZOOM Client** or app on your device in advance (<https://zoom.us/>). If you do not want to install the app, Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge and Firefox Browser work best with ZOOM. Please [click here](#) for further descriptions.
- Your **internet connection** can be improved if you connect via ethernet cable instead of WiFi. A high-speed internet connection will greatly enhance your participation in the event.
- Use a **headset** if possible. This will help to avoid echoes (also for other participants) and ensure that you are easily understood.
- Switch off unnecessary applications and devices on the same network if possible.
- Frame the camera correctly (ideally also check the light – with the window in your back we might only see you blurred).
- After having started the Zoom Client or app, type in the **Meeting ID and the code** as indicated above (and/or in the email you have received).
